Leadership is a Journey

Why leadership training?

- Leaders are not born , but taught through experience.
 - Formal
 - Informal
- We need skilled, ethical leaders in all parts of society.
- Training provides an opportunity to gain knowledge about what leadership should be.

Leadership training is preventative training



- Youth work together

- Groups become more effective when they interact as an efficient functional unit
- Learn from trial and error.
